Edison's academically challenging curriculum follows the State of Oregon's graduation requirements. Though Edison is independent of Jesuit, a collaborative relationship exists between the two schools, Jesuit students with learning differences (e.g., ADHD, dyslexia) may qualify to enroll in 1-3 classes per year at Edison.
