Jesuit High School, established by the Society of Jesus in 1956, is a Catholic, college-preparatory, four-year secondary school. JHS serves students of all religious faiths. It is located on the west side of Portland, Ore., which has a growing metropolitan population of approximately two million people.

**MISSION** Jesuit education fosters the harmonious development of the adolescent’s gifts: spiritual, religious, intellectual, physical, emotional, and aesthetic. Edison's academically challenging curriculum follows the State of Oregon's graduation requirements. Though Edison is independent of Jesuit, a collaborative relationship exists between the two schools, Jesuit students with learning differences (e.g., ADHD, dyslexia) may qualify to enroll in 1-3 classes per year at Edison.
