- This is the ONLY time each year the student body works together to raise funds for Jesuit
- Our student-led campaign has two main goals:
  - > Reach 100% participation
  - > Raise \$160,000
- \$75,000 will be used to assist students and their families who qualify for financial aid (up \$25,000 from last year!)
- Remaining funds are used to support Jesuit in a variety of other areas

     Like the food drive if giving via VENMO please enter your full name and 3<sup>rd</sup> period teacher into the notes field. Choose private transaction if you can as well.
  - If you have a sibling at Jesuit, the two/three of you are responsible for \$100 total (not each) OR 5 letters/addresses each. We will not count participation for all siblings if one sibling does more letters.
- **Go above and beyond!** Provide more than 10 addresses <u>or</u> raise more than \$100. The funds raised benefit YOU and help those who may not have 10 addresses/\$100 to provide.

### DO:

- ✓ Write a paragraph

   about your experience
   as a Jesuit student
- ✓ Include your activities, clubs and sports
- ✓ Write about your favorite class and/or teacher
- ✓ Provide ten names and addresses of people you know well (Check addresses for accuracy. You will be responsible for correcting addresses on returned letters.)

#### DON'T...

- ...Write to celebrities or public figures whom you do not know personally
- × ...Write to pets or fellow JHS students
- ...Write multiple letters to the same address
   (10 letters = 10 <u>DIFFERENT</u> addresses. For example, you may
   <u>not</u> write separate letters to your aunt and uncle who live at the
   same address.)
- × ...Make up fake names/addresses
- × ...Write a negative paragraph
- × ...Ask for money in your paragraph

Volunteers read and edit **EVERY** letter.

Letters to fictitious or inappropriate addresses will be taken very seriously and...
